

Public Notice

CEMX, Inc. in cooperation with the City of Hesperia has applied for grant funding from the California State Parks, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division for the 2014/2015 Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program. The application process includes notifying the general public. Preliminary applications are due to the OHMVR Division on March 7, 2016, with Final applications due on May 2, 2016.

The grant application is for matching funds of approximately \$392,729. If approved and funded, the grant will help CEMX, Inc. continue to provide off-highway vehicle recreation at Competitive Edge Motocross (CEMX) located in Hesperia, CA. Project funds will be used to help maintain the tracks, offer OHV safety training courses and keep CEMX open providing a viable, safe, clean and well managed regional OHV recreational area in the manner that meets the intent of OHMVR Recreation Act of 2003.
